## TECHNICAL INFORMATION ABOUT NATURAL LIMESTONE

Halquist natural Midwestern dolomite limestone tiles were tested by an independent laboratory for slip resistance in accordance with ASTM C1028 (Standard Test Method for Evaluating the Static Coefficient of Friction of Ceramic Tile and Other Like Surfaces by the Horizontal Dynamometer Pull Meter Method).

These independent studies show that Halquist's Midwestern Limestone Pavers and Tiles average \* a slip resistance of .87 on a dry surface and .77 when wet. This exceeds New York City's strict Department of Transportation minimum requirement of slip resistance of 0.55. Both ASTM and ANSI do not publish minimum requirements for slip resistance.
